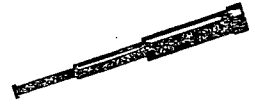

conspicuous (adj) - easily seen; noticeable	Jered was <u>conspicuous</u> in his chicken costume.
envision (v) - to picture in one's mind; to imagine	I cannot <u>envision</u> what this city will be like in fifty years.
kaleidoscope (n) - an instrument for viewing objects arranged in changing but symmetrical patterns	The children played happily for hours with the <u>kaleidoscope</u> , watching the changing patterns.
perspective (n) - a way of drawing objects; an evaluation of a problem by considering all the parts of the problem; an outlook or frame of mind	The <u>perspective</u> in the painting was not completely correct, so the buildings seemed out of proportion.
specimen (n) - part of the whole; a sample	The scientist examined the <u>specimen</u> under the microscope.
spectrum (n) - colored bands that are arranged by their wave lengths when a white light passes through a prism	The <u>spectrum</u> of the rainbow changed from yellow to purple.
speculate (v) - to think about something; viewing it from different points of view	She <u>speculated</u> about her chances of getting the part in the play.
visibility (n) - the ability to be seen	The sign's <u>visibility</u> upset all the neighbors.
vista (n) - a view or outlook	The <u>vista</u> from the edge of the canyon was awesome.
visual (adj) - relating to sight; used in seeing; able to be seen	He included several <u>visual</u> aids with his report.
