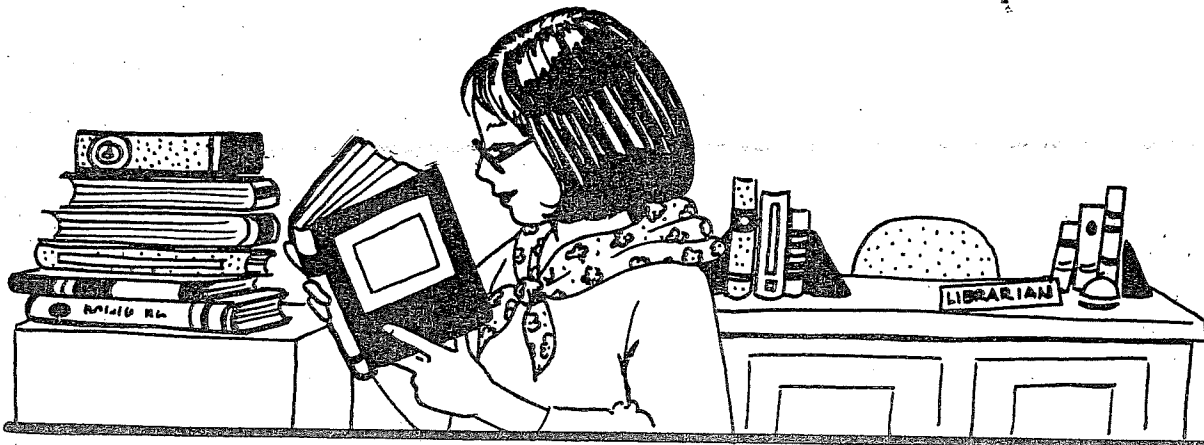

embody (v) - to give bodily form to; to give tangible or concrete form to	Her life <u>embodied</u> the principals of love, patience and forgiveness.
enamor (v) - to be in love with; to charm; to captivate	The librarian was <u>enamored</u> of books.
imbibe (v) - to consume a liquid; to absorb; to drink in; to take into the mind	His habit of <u>imbibing</u> ten sodas a day was not good for his health.
immigrate (v) - to come to a country different from one's native country	My ancestors <u>immigrated</u> to this country 100 years ago from Norway.
induct (v) - bring into a group as a member	The club <u>inducts</u> new members at the first meeting of each month.
influx (n) - a flowing in; a continuous stream of people or things	There was a sudden <u>influx</u> of water in the stream when the dam developed a leak.
intrastate (adj) - occurring within a state	All <u>intrastate</u> roads are maintained by the state highways department.
introspection (n) - looking within; an analysis of one's own mental and emotional state	After some <u>introspection</u> , I realize that I was terribly wrong.
introvert (v) - to focus all interests and emotions on oneself; to turn inward	Charles would be happier if he would share his feelings instead of <u>introverting</u> them.
